HOUSE BILL NO. 1255

- AN ACT TO CREATE THE RURAL MISSISSIPPI MOSQUITO ABATEMENT 1 2 ACT; TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES FOR MOSQUITO 3 ABATEMENT; TO CREATE THE RURAL MISSISSIPPI MOSQUITO ABATEMENT FUND 4
- AND PROVIDE FOR ITS ADMINISTRATION; TO REQUIRE AN APPROPRIATION TO
- 5 THE FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. (1) There is established the Rural Mississippi 7
- 8 Mosquito Abatement Act. The purpose of this fund is to provide
- 9 grants to towns and municipalities with populations of less than
- 10 twenty thousand (20,000) to establish a comprehensive mosquito
- abatement program. Monies from this fund shall be administered by 11
- 12 the Mississippi Department of Health.
- (2) Any eliqible town or municipality may submit an 13
- application for assistance in mosquito abatement, to the 14
- Department of Health. The application must include a description 15
- of the purpose for which assistance is requested, the amount of 16
- assistance requested and any other information required by the 17
- Department of Health. Grant applications may request equipment 18
- 19 and/or funds to establish a local abatement program. Grants
- awarded of up to Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) may be 20
- awarded under this section. 21
- (3) There is created in the State Treasury a special fund to 2.2
- be designated as the "Rural Mississippi Mosquito Abatement Fund," 23
- which shall consist of funds appropriated or otherwise made 24
- 25 available by the Legislature in any manner and funds from any
- other source designated for deposit into such fund. 26
- Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal 27
- 28 year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any

- 29 investment earnings or interest earned on amounts in the fund
- 30 shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. Monies in the fund
- 31 shall be distributed to eligible towns by the Department of Health
- 32 for the purposes described in this section.
- 33 (4) During the 2007 regular legislative session the
- 34 Legislature shall appropriate Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 35 (\$500,000.00) to the Rural Mississippi Mosquito Abatement Fund.
- 36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 2007.
