1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 21-1-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THAT WARD LINES BE DRAWN BEFORE A CHANCELLOR MAY APPROVE A 2 3 PROPOSED ENLARGEMENT OF A MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 21-1-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 6 21-1-33. If the chancellor finds from the evidence presented 7 8 at such hearing that the proposed enlargement or contraction is 9 reasonable and is required by the public convenience and necessity and, in the event of an enlargement of a municipality, that 10 11 reasonable public and municipal services will be rendered in the annexed territory within a reasonable time and after ward lines 12 13 have been drawn for an enlargement of a municipality, the 14 chancellor shall enter a decree approving, ratifying and confirming the proposed enlargement or contraction, and describing 15 the boundaries of the municipality as altered. In so doing the 16 17 chancellor shall have the right and the power to modify the proposed enlargement or contraction by decreasing the territory to 18 be included in or excluded from such municipality, as the case may 19 20 be. If the chancellor shall find from the evidence that the proposed enlargement or contraction, as the case may be, is 21 unreasonable and is not required by the public convenience and 2.2 necessity, then he shall enter a decree denying such enlargement 23 In any event, the decree of the chancellor shall 24 or contraction. 25 become effective after the passage of ten (10) days from the date thereof or, in event an appeal is taken therefrom, within ten (10) 26 27 days from the final determination of such appeal.
