- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** It shall be unlawful to possess a sub-woofer in a
- 7 motor vehicle in excess of 100hertz. A person who violates the
- 8 provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and,
- 9 upon conviction, shall be fined not less than Two Hundred Fifty
- 10 Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or
- 11 imprisoned for not more than sixty (60) days, or both.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** Section 97-35-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 13 amended as follows:
- 14 97-35-9. Except as otherwise provided in Section 1 of this
- 15 act, a person who willfully disturbs the peace of any family or
- 16 person by an explosion of gunpowder or other explosive substance,
- 17 or by loud or unusual noise, or by any tumultuous or offensive
- 18 conduct, shall be punished by fine or imprisonment, or both; the
- 19 fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and the
- 20 imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months in the county jail.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2007.
