HOUSE BILL NO. 1340

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRACKING OF CERTAIN FEDERAL GRANT 1 2 FUNDS THAT ARE TO BE PROVIDED TO THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR 3 ASSISTANCE TO HOMEOWNERS WHOSE HOMES WERE DAMAGED OR DESTROYED BY 4 HURRICANE KATRINA; TO DIRECT THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO OBTAIN AND COMPILE IN A DATABASE THE CERTAIN INFORMATION FOR 5 б EACH ASSISTANCE GRANT MADE TO A HOMEOWNER WHOSE HOME WAS DAMAGED 7 OR DESTROYED BY HURRICANE KATRINA; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI 8 DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY SHALL POST ON ITS WEB SITE ON A MONTHLY 9 BASIS CERTAIN INFORMATION RELATING TO THE ASSISTANCE GRANTS; AND 10 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 **SECTION 1.** (1) The purpose of this section is to provide a method for tracking Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds 13 14 that are to be provided to the State of Mississippi under the Fiscal Year 2006 Department of Defense Appropriations Act (H.R. 15 16 2863) for assistance to homeowners whose homes were damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Katrina. With this information obtained 17 under this section, public officials will be better able to 18 19 determine if those grant funds are being provided to the most 20 affected areas and if the grant funds are being distributed 21 equitably.

(2) The Mississippi Development Authority (MDA) shall obtain and compile in a database the following information for each grant of CDBG funds to a homeowner whose home was damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Katrina:

26 (a) The address of the house to be repaired or rebuilt27 with the grant;

(b) The amount of the grant disbursed by address; and
(c) The use of the grant (repair or rebuild) by
address.

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31 (3) From the information compiled under subsection (2), the 32 MDA shall post the following information by supervisors district 33 on its Web site on a monthly basis:

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(a) The number of grant recipients; and

35 (b) The total number and amount of grants disbursed. (4) 36 The MDA may provide the information compiled under 37 subsection (2) to the Mississippi Automated Resource Information 38 System (MARIS) or other appropriate agencies or entities with mapping capability in order to track the distribution of grant 39 40 funds by supervisors district; however, no other personal information pertaining to a grant recipient may be posted on MDA's 41 Web site or divulged by MDA to any person, agency or entity, 42 including the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the 43 Mississippi Emergency Management Agency. Any information obtained 44 by MDA with regard to CDBG funds provided to a homeowner, other 45 46 than the information specified in subsection (2), shall be exempt 47 from the Mississippi Public Records Act, Section 25-61-1 et seq. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 48 49 and after its passage.
