- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 47-5-572, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 47-5-572. (1) A privately operated correctional facility
- 11 shall not procure goods, to be used by inmates housed in
- 12 Mississippi facilities, that have been manufactured using inmates
- 13 in a correctional system of another state if Mississippi Prison
- 14 Industries is presently manufacturing the same goods using
- 15 Mississippi inmates, unless the cost of the goods and services can
- 16 be procured at a price that is at least thirty percent (30%) less
- 17 than the cost of the same goods and services provided by
- 18 Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation.
- 19 (2) This section shall stand repealed from and after July 1,
- 20 2009.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2007.
