- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** The following provisions shall be applicable in
- 6 actions for the payment and collection of child support in the
- 7 State of Mississippi, notwithstanding any other provision of law
- 8 to the contrary:
- 9 (a) When a person is a defendant in an action for the
- 10 payment of child support, the court shall complete the proceedings
- 11 and issue an order in the action not later than one hundred twenty
- 12 (120) days after the date that the action is filed, or the
- 13 proceedings shall be dismissed.
- 14 (b) When a court order for the payment of child support
- 15 is entered against a person that provides for an encumbrance
- 16 against the person's personal assets or property, the person shall
- 17 be served with the required process not later than forty-five (45)
- 18 days after the date that the encumbrance is filed, or the action
- 19 for the encumbrance shall be void.
- 20 (c) When a person is subject to a court order for the
- 21 payment of child support, and the amount of the person's income
- 22 increases or the person's resources increase for any reason after
- 23 the entry of that order, the court shall not increase the amount
- 24 that the person must pay for child support above the amount that
- 25 was specified in the initial court order.
- 26 (d) When a person is subject to a court order for the
- 27 payment of child support, and the person has properly and timely

- 28 made the child support payments as required by that order for a
- 29 period of two (2) years, the court shall terminate all judgments
- 30 and encumbrances against that person and his personal assets and
- 31 property for the payment of child support.
- 32 (e) When a person who is subject to a court order for
- 33 child support is married to a person who is not the natural parent
- 34 of the child for whom the child support payments are to be made,
- 35 the assets of that spouse shall not be subject to withholding or
- 36 any other encumbrance for payment of support for that child.
- 37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after July 1, 2007.
