HOUSE BILL NO. 1474

AN ACT TO CREATE A FELONY OFFENSE FOR REMOVING GRAVE MARKERS;
TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; TO AMEND SECTION 97-17-39,
MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. It shall be a felony to remove any military

marker, bronze vase, marker, memorial, statue or plaque from any

- 7 grave. A violation of this section shall be punishable by
- 8 imprisonment for up to ten (10) years in the custody of the
- 9 Department of Corrections and a person convicted under this
- 10 section shall be liable for all damages to such markers.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 97-17-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 12 amended as follows:

- 97-17-39. Except as provided in Section 1 of this act, if
- 14 any person, by any means whatever, shall willfully or
- 15 mischievously injure or destroy any of the burial vaults, urns,
- 16 memorials, vases, foundations, bases or other similar items in a
- 17 cemetery, or injure or destroy any of the work, materials, or
- 18 furniture of any courthouse or jail, or other public building, or
- 19 schoolhouse or church, or deface any of the walls or other parts
- 20 thereof, or shall write, or make any drawings or
- 21 character, or do any other act, either on or in said building or
- 22 the walls thereof, or shall deface or injure the trees, fences,
- 23 pavements, or soil, on the grounds belonging thereto, or an
- 24 ornamental or shade tree on any public road or street leading
- 25 thereto, such person, upon conviction, for such offense, shall be
- 26 punished as follows:

- 27 (a) If the damage caused by the destruction or
- 28 defacement of such property has a value of less than Three Hundred
- 29 Dollars (\$300.00), any person who is convicted of such offense
- 30 shall be fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or
- 31 be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than one (1) year,
- 32 or both.
- 33 (b) If the damage caused by the destruction or
- 34 defacement of such property has a value equal to or exceeding
- 35 Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), any person who is convicted of
- 36 such offense shall be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars
- 37 (\$5,000.00) or be imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for up to
- 38 five (5) years, or both.
- 39 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after July 1, 2007.
