- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** No person other than certified law enforcement
- 6 officers shall possess a portable device or weapon from which an
- 7 electric current, impulse, wave or beam may be directed, which
- 8 current, impulse, wave or beam is designed to incapacitate
- 9 temporarily, injure or kill. The purpose of these portable
- 10 devices and weapons is to momentarily stun, knock out, cause
- 11 mental disorientation, or paralyze. Whoever violates this section
- 12 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be
- 13 punished by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)
- 14 nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment
- 15 for not less than six (6) months nor more than one (1) year, or
- 16 both.
