HOUSE BILL NO. 1505

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 9-7-23 AND 9-7-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE FOR FIVE JUDGES FOR THE SEVENTH CIRCUIT COURT DISTRICT; TO REVISE THE SUBDISTRICTS OF THE SEVENTH CIRCUIT COURT
- 4 DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 9-7-23, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 9-7-23. (1) The Seventh Circuit Court District shall be
- 9 comprised of Hinds County.
- 10 (2) The Seventh Circuit Court District shall be divided into
- 11 <u>five (5)</u> subdistricts in Hinds County as follows:
- 12 (a) Subdistrict 7-1 shall be the same as Supervisor
- 13 <u>District 1</u>.
- 14 (b) Subdistrict 7-2 shall be the same as Supervisor
- 15 District 2.
- 16 (c) Subdistrict 7-3 shall be the same as Supervisor
- 17 District 3.
- 18 (d) Subdistrict 7-4 shall be the same as Supervisor
- 19 District 4.
- (e) Subdistrict 7-5 shall be the same as Supervisor
- 21 District 5.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** Section 9-7-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 23 amended as follows:
- 9-7-25. (1) There shall be <u>five (5)</u> circuit judges for the
- 25 Seventh Circuit Court District. One (1) judge shall be elected
- 26 from each subdistrict.
- 27 (2) While there shall be no limitation whatsoever upon the
- 28 powers and duties of the said judges other than as cast upon them

- 29 by the Constitution and laws of this state, the court in the First
- 30 Judicial District of Hinds County, in the discretion of the senior
- 31 circuit judge, may be divided into civil and criminal divisions as
- 32 a matter of convenience, by the entry of an order upon the minutes
- 33 of the court.
- 34 SECTION 3. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 35 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 36 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 37 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 38 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 39 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 40 extended.
- 41 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 43 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
