HOUSE BILL NO. 1519

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-26-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 DELETE THE EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS FROM THE 2 REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THE MISSISSIPPI SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT; 3 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 41-26-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 8 41-26-5. (1) In addition to any other duties required by 9 law, the board shall have the following powers and duties concerning safe drinking water: 10 11 (a) To establish policies, requirements or standards governing the source, collection, distribution, purification, 12 13 treatment and storage of water for public water systems as it deems necessary for the provision of safe drinking water; 14 15 (b) To adopt, modify, repeal and promulgate, after due 16 notice and hearing and in accordance with the Mississippi 17 Administrative Procedures Law and Section 41-26-6, and where not otherwise prohibited by federal or state law, to make exceptions 18 to and grant exemptions and variances from, and to enforce rules 19 and regulations implementing the powers and duties of the board 20 21 under this chapter; 22 (c) To enter into, and to authorize the director to 23 execute contracts, grants and cooperative agreements with, any federal or state agency or subdivision thereof, interstate agency, 24 25 or any other person in connection with carrying out this chapter; 26 and (d) To discharge other powers, duties and 27 28 responsibilities which may be necessary to implement this chapter. * HR07/ R1533* H. 29 (2) * * * Regulations adopted under this section shall apply
30 to each public water system in the state.

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The board shall develop and implement a technical 32 (3) 33 assistance program to help existing potentially nonviable community public water systems to become viable and to improve the 34 technical, managerial or financial capabilities of small community 35 public water systems. In developing this program, the board shall 36 work cooperatively with organizations that currently provide 37 38 training and assistance to public water systems. 39 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

40 and after July 1, 2007.
