HOUSE BILL NO. 1523 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-61-75, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT IN DEATH CASES WHERE THE CAUSE OF DEATH WAS SUDDEN 3 INFANT DEATH SYNDROME (SIDS) AND THE MEDICAL EXAMINER PROVIDES A SIDS DEATH SCENE INVESTIGATION REPORT, THE COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINERS SHALL RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$50.00, OR AN 6 ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$100.00 IF THE MEDICAL EXAMINER HAS RECEIVED 7 ADVANCED TRAINING IN CHILD DEATH INVESTIGATIONS; TO REQUIRE THE STATE MEDICAL EXAMINER TO DEVELOP A UNIFORM FORMAT FOR SIDS/CHILD DEATH SCENE INVESTIGATION REPORTS TO BE USED BY THE COUNTY MEDICAL 8 9 EXAMINERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 12 **SECTION 1.** Section 41-61-75, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 13 amended as follows: 14 41-61-75. (1) For each investigation with the preparation and submission of the required reports, the following fees shall 15 16 be billed to and paid by the county for which the service is 17 provided: 18 (a) A medical examiner or his deputy shall receive 19 Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00) for each completed report of 20 investigation of death, plus the examiner's actual expenses. addition to that fee, in cases where the cause of death was sudden 21 infant death syndrome (SIDS) and the medical examiner provides a 22 SIDS Death Scene Investigation report, the medical examiner shall 23 24 receive for completing that report an additional Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), or an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) if the 25 26 medical examiner has received advanced training in child death 27 investigations and presents to the county a certificate of completion of that advanced training. The State Medical Examiner 28

shall develop and prescribe a uniform format and list of matters

to be contained in SIDS/Child Death Scene Investigation reports,

- 33 (b) The pathologist performing autopsies as provided in
- 34 Section 41-61-65 shall receive Five Hundred Fifty Dollars
- 35 (\$550.00) per completed autopsy, plus mileage expenses to and from
- 36 the site of the autopsy.
- 37 (2) Any medical examiner, physician or pathologist who is
- 38 subpoenaed for appearance and testimony before a grand jury,
- 39 courtroom trial or deposition shall be entitled to an expert
- 40 witness hourly fee to be set by the court and mileage expenses to
- 41 and from the site of the testimony, and such amount shall be paid
- 42 by the jurisdiction or party issuing the subpoena.
- 43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after October 1, 2007, and this act shall stand repealed on
- 45 <u>June 30, 2011</u>.
