- AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 7-5-58, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE DEFENDANTS WHO ARE SUBJECTS OF INVESTIGATION BY THE PUBLIC 2 3 INTEGRITY UNIT OF THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO PAY THE

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 7
- 8 7-5-58, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 7-5-58. (1) In addition to any criminal penalties, the 9
- court shall assess a defendant convicted of a violation 10
- investigated by the Public Integrity Unit of the Office of the 11
- 12 Attorney General including, but not limited to, investigations by
- the Cyber Crime Division, the Child Support Division or the 13
- Vulnerable Adult Division, double the reasonable costs of the 14
- investigation. Costs should be paid to the Office of the Attorney 15
- General and include, but are not limited to, the cost of 16
- investigators, service of process, court reporters, expert 17
- 18 witnesses and attorney's fees expended by the Public Integrity
- Unit in the investigation of such case. 19
- (2) Any additional monetary penalty assessed and levied 20
- 21 under this section shall be deposited one-half (1/2) to the credit
- of the State General Fund and one-half (1/2) to the Office of the 2.2
- Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General may 23
- institute and maintain proceedings in his name for enforcement of 24
- payment in the circuit court of the county of residence of the 25
- defendant and, if the defendant is a nonresident, such proceedings 26
- shall be in the Circuit Court of the First Judicial District of 27
- 28 Hinds County, Mississippi.
