HOUSE BILL NO. 1650

1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF 2 3 COSMETOLOGY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Cosmetology, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year 8 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 9 .....\$ 827,471.00. 10 11 SECTION 2. Of the funds approved for expenditure under the provisions of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below 12 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 13 14 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 15 Personal Services: 16 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 17 456,490.00 18 Travel and Subsistence..... 129,362.00 Contractual Services..... 216,912.00 19 20 Commodities..... 18,207.00 Capital Outlay: 21 0.00 22 Other Than Equipment..... 6,500.00 23 Equipment..... Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 44 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 45 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 48 act. 49 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 51 52 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 53 54 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 55 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 56 57 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 58 59 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

No. 1650 07/HR05/A822 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 60 61 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 62 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 63 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 65 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 67 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 68 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

73 SECTION 3. If not needed for other purposes, the State Treasurer shall invest any part of or all monies herein approved 74 75 and any surplus funds of the State Board of Cosmetology for a 76 period of ninety (90) days or more at the highest rate of interest obtainable and credit such to this respective fund. Monies shall 77 be invested by the Treasurer in any short-term bonds, notes or 78 79 other direct obligations of the United States of America or the 80 State of Mississippi or any county or municipality of this state, 81 which county or municipal bonds have been approved by a reputable 82 bond attorney or have been validated by a decree of the court, or in savings accounts or certificates of deposit of a state or 83 84 national bank in the State of Mississippi, or in federally insured savings and loan associations in the State of Mississippi; and in 85 86 any event, the bonds, notes or obligations in which such funds are invested shall mature or be redeemable prior to the time the funds 87 88 so invested will be needed for the purposes herein provided.

89 **SECTION 4.** It is the intent of this legislation to provide 90 the funds for the board to meet when necessary, but under no 91 circumstances shall it meet more than sixty-two (62) days a year.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92 93 State Board of Cosmetology shall maintain complete accounting and 94 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 95 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 96 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 97 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to 98 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 99 100 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 101 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

102 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 103 104 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 105 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 106 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 107 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 108 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 109 made without competitive bids.

110 **SECTION 7.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 111 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 112 113 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 114 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 115 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 116 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2007. 117
