HOUSE BILL NO. 1653

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2008. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: б SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 8 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical 9 Therapy, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year 10 11 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... \$ 249,398.00. 12 13 SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 14 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 15 16 Permanent: Full Time..... 3 17 Part Time..... 0 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 18 0 Part Time..... 19 0 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 20 21 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 22 equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever 23 24 is greater. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 25 26 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 27 28 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 * HR05/ A837* H. 29 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 30 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 31 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 32 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 34 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 35 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 36 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 37 38 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 39 40 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 41 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 43 44 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 45 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 46

47 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 48 49 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 50 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 51 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 52 53 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 54 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 55 appropriated level.

56 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 57 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 58 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 59 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

60 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 61 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain

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62 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 63 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 64 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of 65 66 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 67 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 68 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 69 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 70 process.

71 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 72 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 73 74 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 75 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 76 77 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 78 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 79 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 81 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 82 83 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 84 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 85 86 and after July 1, 2007.

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
