1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of
10	the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of
11	defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of
12	the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building
14	Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose
15	of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System
16	Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
17	June 30, 2008\$ 11,460,285.00.
18	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
20	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
21	expenditure:

40	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
41	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
42	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
43	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever
44	is greater.
45	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
46	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
47	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
48	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
49	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
50	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
51	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
52	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
53	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
54	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
55	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
56	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
57	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
58	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
59	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
60	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency

- 62 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
- 63 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 64 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 65 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 66 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 68 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 69 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 70 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 71 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 72 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 73 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 74 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 75 appropriated level.
- 76 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 77 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 78 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 79 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 80 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 81 Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System shall
- 82 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 83 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 84 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 85 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of
- 86 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 87 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 88 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 89 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request
- 90 process.
- 91 **SECTION 4.** In accordance with the purposes of this article,
- 92 there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public
- 93 Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund,
- 94 into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income

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95 from the building owned by the system located at 301 North
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- 96 President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal
- 97 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the
- 98 Administrative Budget Fund of the system.
- 99 It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have
- 100 the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System
- 101 Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed
- 102 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for repair and
- 103 maintenance of the buildings owned by the system. All
- 104 expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building
- 105 Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this
- 106 article and for the purposes designated herein.
- 107 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 108 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 109 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 110 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 111 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 112 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 113 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 114 made without competitive bids.
- 115 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 116 Executive Director of the Public Employees' Retirement System may
- increase major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to
- 118 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of
- 119 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major
- 120 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar
- 121 amount and provided the Executive Director of the Mississippi
- 122 Department of Finance and Administration also approves with
- 123 written authorization. However, no transfers shall be authorized
- 124 which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages
- 125 and Fringe Benefits."
- 126 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that, with
- 127 the funds appropriated in Section 1, the Public Employees

128	Retirement System is authorized to implement, in compliance with
129	the rules and regulations of the State Personnel Board, the
130	actions recommended in the State Personnel Board PERS
131	Organizational Study.
132	SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums herein
133	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
134	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
135	to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of the Public
136	Employees' Retirement System, for the purpose of defraying those
137	expenses associated with consultant services regarding a
138	replacement computer system, for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
139	2007, and ending June 30, 2008\$ 480,458.00.
140	SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
141	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
142	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
143	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
144	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
145	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
146	SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from
147	and after July 1, 2007.
