1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PAT HARRISON WATERWAY 2 3 DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the Pat Harrison Waterway District, for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year 9 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 10 11 8,450,783.00. SECTION 2. Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 39 40 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 42 43 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 44 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 45 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 47 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 49 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 50 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 51 52 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 53 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 54 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 55 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 56 57 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 58 59 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 60 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 61 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 63 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 64 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 65 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 66 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 67 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 68 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 69 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

74 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 75 Pat Harrison Waterway District shall maintain complete accounting 76 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 77 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 78 79 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to 80 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 81 82 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 83 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 84 85 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 86 87 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 88 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 89 90 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 91 made without competitive bids.

92 SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except 93 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which H. B. No. 1657 *HR05/A480* 07/HR05/A480 PAGE 3 (RM\ST) 94 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, 95 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the 96 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent 97 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills 98 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

99 SECTION 6. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 100 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 101 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2007.
