## HOUSE BILL NO. 1658

1 2 3	AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PEARL RIVER BASIN DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out
7	of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available
8	to the Pearl River Basin Development District, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
11	\$ 1,854,792.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds approved for expenditure under the
13	provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time
16	Part Time 3
17	Time-Limited: Full Time
18	Part Time0
19	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
20	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
21	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
22	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever
23	is greater.
24	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
25	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
26	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
27	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008

- 28 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
- 29 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
- 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 31 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 34 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
- 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 39 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 41 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
- 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 43 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 48 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 49 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 51 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 52 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 53 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 54 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 59 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 60 Pearl River Basin Development District shall maintain complete

accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 61 62 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 63 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 64 65 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 66 67 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 68 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 69 70 Director of the Pearl River Basin Development District shall be authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from any source, 71 not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), for the 72 purpose of maintaining the Lower Pearl Restoration Project in 73 74 accordance with the Project Cooperation Agreement with the United 75 States Army Corps of Engineers and to maintain the South Jackson 76 Clearing Project in an area along the Pearl River in Hinds County 77 and Rankin County, in accordance with rules and regulations of the 78 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 79 with the escalation of federal funds. 80 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that

whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

88 **SECTION 6.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except
89 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which
90 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,
91 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the
92 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent

- 93 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills
- 94 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.
- 95 **SECTION 7.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall
- 96 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
- 97 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with
- 98 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.
- 99 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 100 and after July 1, 2007.
