- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 62 63 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 64 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 65 66 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 67 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 68 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 70 appropriated level. 71 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 72 73 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 74 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 75 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Board of Examiners for Social Workers and Marriage and Family 76 77 Therapists shall maintain complete accounting and personnel 78 records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and 79 level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further 80 the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request 81 82 for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative 83 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 84 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 85 budget request process.
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 86 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 87 88 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 89 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 90 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 91 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 92 93 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1 2007
