HOUSE BILL NO. 1664

1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE TOMBIGBEE RIVER VALLEY 2 3 WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available 8 to the Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, for the purpose of paying bond maturities, accrued interest, maintenance 9 expenses, project development costs, and any other authorized 10 11 expenses of the water management district, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 12 13 \$ 4,284,827.00. 14 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 15 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 16 17 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 18 Personal Services: 19 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 20 919,927.00 Travel and Subsistence..... 70,000.00 21 Contractual Services..... 22 600,000.00 Commodities..... 250,000.00 23 24 Capital Outlay: 25 Other Than Equipment..... 1,983,000.00 Equipment..... 346,300.00 26 27 Vehicles..... 60,000.00

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 41 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 42 43 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 44 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 45 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 46 47 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 48 49 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 50 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 51 act. 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 53 54 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 55 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 56 57 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 58 59 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 60 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

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63 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 65 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 66 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 67 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 68 69 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 70 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 71

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

76 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 77 Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District shall maintain 78 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 79 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 80 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of 81 82 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 83 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 84 85 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 86 process.

87 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 91 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

95 SECTION 5. All monies in possession of the district in 96 excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank 97 or banks selected by the board of directors of the district. 98 These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such 99 manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest 100 earnings on state funds deposited by the State Treasury.

101 **SECTION 6.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 102 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 103 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

104 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 105 and after July 1, 2007.
