1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI COAST 2 3 COLISEUM COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi Coast Coliseum Commission, for the purpose of 8 defraying expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning 9 July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 10 11 .....\$ 4,092,491.00. SECTION 2. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 40 41 Mississippi Coast Coliseum Commission shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 42 43 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 44 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 45 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 46 47 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 48 49 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

50 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 51 52 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 53 54 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 55 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 56 57 made without competitive bids.

58 **SECTION 5.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 59 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 60 or officers, in the manner provided by law.
