6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
8	Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registration for		
9	Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors, for the purpose of		
10	defraying the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning		
11	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008 \$ 499,423.00.		
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds approved for expenditure under the

53	If, at the time the	e agency takes any action to change "Personal
54	Services," the Stat	e Personnel Board determines that the agency
55	has taken an action	which would cause the agency to exceed this
56	projected annual co	ost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
57	appropriated level,	when annualized, then only those actions which
58	reduce the projecte	ed annual cost and/or the appropriation
59	requirement will be	e processed by the State Personnel Board until
60	such time as the re	equirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 61 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 63 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 64 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 65 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 66 67 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 68 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 69 appropriated level. 70 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 71 72 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 73 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 74 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land 75 76 Surveyors shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records 77 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of 78 79 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for 80 Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative 81 82 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 83 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 84 budget request process. SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 85 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 86 87 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 88 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 89 90 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 91

made without competitive bids.

93	SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
94	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
95	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
96	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
97	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
98	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
99	SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
100	and after July 1, 2007.
