HOUSE BILL NO. 1670

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING  
2 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE PORT AUTHORITY AT GULFPORT  
3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out  
7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available  
8 to the Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport, for the  
9 purpose of defraying the expenses of the authority for the fiscal  
10 year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008.....  
11 ..... \$ 49,228,144.00.

12 **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of  
13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be  
14 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of  
15 expenditure:

16 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:

17 Personal Services:

18 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 3,097,536.00  
19 Travel and Subsistence..... 135,050.00  
20 Contractual Services..... 3,070,753.00  
21 Commodities..... 169,505.00

22 Capital Outlay:

23 Other Than Equipment..... 38,735,000.00  
24 Equipment..... 744,000.00  
25 Vehicles..... 50,000.00  
26 Wireless Communication Devices..... 6,000.00  
27 Subsidies, Loans and Grants..... 3,220,300.00

34 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with  
35 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

36 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
37 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are  
38 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this  
39 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

40 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the  
41 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain  
42 complete accounting and personnel records related to the  
43 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such  
44 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as  
45 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of  
46 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year  
47 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee  
48 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level  
49 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request  
50 process.

51 **SECTION 4.** In the event of a natural disaster or other major  
52 catastrophe whereby the expenditure of funds above the limits  
53 contained herein are deemed necessary to rapidly repair or restore  
54 port facilities, the Port Authority and the Mississippi  
55 Development Authority, with the approval of the Department of  
56 Finance and Administration, may escalate expenditures under  
57 Section 1 and the major objects contained in Section 2. However,  
58 no escalation shall be authorized until source and availability of  
59 such funds is shown.



60           **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the  
61 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized  
62 to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with  
63 applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and  
64 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of  
65 federal funds.

66           **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that  
67 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the  
68 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things  
69 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,  
70 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind  
71 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to  
72 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are  
73 made without competitive bids.

74           **SECTION 7.** The money appropriated under the provisions of  
75 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper  
76 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

77           **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
78 and after July 1, 2007.
