5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be					
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out

10	year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008

- SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
  Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized
  to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with
  applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
  Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
  federal funds.
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

It is the intention of the Legislature that

- SECTION 7. The money appropriated under the provisions of
  Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper
  person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 77 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 78 and after July 1, 2007.
