4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:		
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
7	Treasury to the credit of the Oil and Gas Conservation Fund, for		
8	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Oil and Gas		
9	Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending		
10	June 30, 2008\$ 2,579,72	1.00.	
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
12	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be		
13	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of		
14	expenditure:

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- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 61 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 62 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 63 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 65 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 67 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 68 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 70 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 71 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 72 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 73 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 74 State Oil and Gas Board shall maintain complete accounting and
- 75 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 76 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 77 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 78 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 79 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
- 80 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 81 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 82 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
- 83 **SECTION 4.** With the funds provided herein, it is the
- 84 intention of the Legislature that the State Oil and Gas Board
- 85 purchase liability insurance.
- 86 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 87 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 88 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 89 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 90 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 91 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

- 92 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 93 made without competitive bids.
- 94 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 95 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 96 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 97 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 98 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 99 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 100 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 101 and after July 1, 2007.
