HOUSE BILL NO. 1675

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 PUBLIC UTILITIES STAFF FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 Treasury to the credit of the Public Utilities Staff Regulation 8 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Public Utilities Staff for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and 9 ending June 30, 2008.....\$ 2,348,708.00. 10 11 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 12 13 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 14 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 15 Personal Services: 16 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 2,018,628.00 17 18 Travel and Subsistence..... 80,000.00 Contractual Services..... 228,080.00 19 20 Commodities..... 17,000.00 Capital Outlay: 21 0.00 22 Other Than Equipment..... 5,000.00 23 Equipment..... Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 44 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 45 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 48 act. 49 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 51 52 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 53 54 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 55 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 56 57 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 58 59 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

No. 1675 07/HR05/A812 PAGE 2 (RM\ST) Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 60 61 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 62 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 63 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 65 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 67 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 68 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

73 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 74 Public Utilities Staff shall maintain complete accounting and 75 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 76 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 77 78 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 79 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to 80 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 81 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 82 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

83 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 84 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 85 86 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 87 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 88 89 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 90 made without competitive bids.

91 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 92 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

No. 1675 07/HR05/A812 PAGE 3 (RM\ST) 93 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 94 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 95 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 96 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 97 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 98 and after July 1, 2007.
