1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES STAFF FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Public Utilities Staff Regulation
8	Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Public
9	Utilities Staff for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and
10	ending June 30, 2008\$ 2,382,237.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
13	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
14	expenditure:

28 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 29 Permanent: Full Time..... 30 30 Part Time..... 0 31 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 32 Part Time..... 33 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 34 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 35 equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever 36 37 is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 41 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 44 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 45 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 48 49 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds 51 52 and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board 53 54 determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 55 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 56 57 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State 58 59 Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 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- 61 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance
- 62 report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in
- 63 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 66 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 68 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 72 appropriated level.
- 73 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 74 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 75 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 76 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 77 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 78 Public Utilities Staff shall maintain complete accounting and
- 79 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 80 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 81 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 82 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 83 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
- 84 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 85 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 86 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
- 87 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 91 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 93 made without competitive bids.

- SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 95
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 96
- 97 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 98
- Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 99
- proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 100
- SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 101
- and after July 1, 2007. 102
