1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI LIBRARY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying
9	out the provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972,
10	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
11	June 30, 2008\$ 12,896,991.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
15	Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds
16	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the
17	purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal
18	year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
19	\$ 2,692,244.00.
20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
22	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
23	expenditure:

47	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
48	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
49	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever

51	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
52	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
53	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
54	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
55	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
56	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
57	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
58	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
59	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all

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61 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
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- 62 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual

- 65 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 66 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 67 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 68 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
- 69 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 70 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 71 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 72 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 73 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 74 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 75 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 83 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 84 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

- Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems
- 87 under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid
- 88 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March
- 89 31 and June 30.
- 90 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

- 92 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 93 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

- A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 126 127 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the 128 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 129 Committee for Fiscal Year 2009. SECTION 7. 130 It is the intention of the Legislature that the 131 Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to 132 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and 133 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 134 135 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 136 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, not less than 137 One Million Three Hundred Four Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-four 138 Dollars (\$1,304,974.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia 139 Database. SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 140 141 Executive Director of the Mississippi Library Commission may 142 increase major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 143 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of 144 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 145 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 146 amount and provided the Executive Director of the Mississippi 147 Department of Finance and Administration also approves with 148 written authorization. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages 149 150 and Fringe Benefits." 151 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated herein, Three Million 152 Two Hundred Eighty-six Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-four Dollars 153 (\$3,286,944.00) is provided for the cost of health insurance for 154 all full-time library staff members in each public library in 155 Mississippi.

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SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that

159	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
160	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

164	SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
165	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

167	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
168	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
169	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
170	SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from
171	and after July 1, 2007.
