With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 182 183 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 184 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 185 186 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 187 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 188 189 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 190 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 191 192 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act.

No. 1690 07/HR05/A330 PAGE 6 (RM\ST) 193 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 194 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 195 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 196 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 197 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 198 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 199 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 200 201 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 202 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 203 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

204 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 205 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 206 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 207 208 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 209 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 210 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 211 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 212 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

217 It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer 218 219 between the various offices authorized herein both funds and 220 positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving 221 office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 222 accordance with Section 27-104-17(3), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 223 224 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 225 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of

It is further the intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth in the original appropriations made under this act.

SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 233 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 234 235 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 236 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi 237 Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for 238 construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 239 240\$ 4,000,000.00.

241 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 242 Department of Rehabilitation Services shall maintain complete 243 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 244 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 245 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 246 247 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 248 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 249 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 250 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

H. B. No. 1690 07/HR05/A330 PAGE 8 (RM\ST) It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 8. Of the funds in Sections 1, 2 and 3, the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services through the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the National Federation for the Blind (NFB) News line service to allow blind and visually impaired persons to access newspapers through toll-free telephone calls.

267 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 268 269 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 270 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 271 272 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 273 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 274 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated herein, the following amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) shall be derived from Treasury Fund No. 3332 for the purpose of matching all available federal funds. The Executive Director shall have the authority to transfer funds herein between the Office of Special Disability budget and the Spinal Cord and Head Injury Trust Fund budget.

282 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 11. 283 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 284 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 285 286 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 287 288 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 289 and after July 1, 2007
