AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER 1 PARKWAY COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF 2 THE COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi River 8 Parkway Commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and 9 ending June 30, 2008.....\$ 23,688.00. 10 11 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi River Parkway Commission shall maintain complete 12 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 13 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 14 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 15 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 16 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 17 18 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 19 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 20 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that 2.1 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 2.2 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 23 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 24 25 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 26

- 27 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 28 made without competitive bids.
- 29 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 31 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 32 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 33 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 34 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 35 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after July 1, 2007.
