Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 83 84 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 85 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 86 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 87 88 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 89 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 90 91 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 92 93 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 94 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual

cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 95 96 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 97 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 98 99 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 100 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 101 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 102 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 103 104 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

105 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 106 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 107 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 108 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 109 The 110 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 111 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 112 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 113

114 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 115 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 116 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 117 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 118 119 Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid shall maintain complete 120 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 121 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 122 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 123 124 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 125 126 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 127

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that 145 146 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 147 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 148 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 149 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 150 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 151 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 152 made without competitive bids.

**SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, an additional amount not less than Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be expended in the Home and Community Based Waiver Program over and above the amount expended in Fiscal Year 2007.
