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| 5 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 7 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 8 | General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and |
| 9 | maintenance of the State Forestry Commission for the fiscal year |
| 10 | beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008 |
| 11 | \$ 20,035,317.00. |
| 12 | SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 13 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special |
| 14 | fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Forestry |
| 15 | Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by |
| 16 | or otherwise available to the commission, for the support and |
| 17 | maintenance of the commission for the fiscal year beginning |
| 18 | July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008 |
| 19 | \$ 10,222,240.00. |
| 20 | Of the funds specified in this section, Two Hundred Fifty |
| 21 | Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be deposited in a fund |
| 22 | created in the State Treasury called the "Forest Improvement |
| 23 | Revolving Fund." Money in this fund shall be used by the State |
| 24 | Forestry Commission to assist in the reforestation and growth |
| 25 | improvement of the forests, woodlands, and publicly owned lands of |

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     generated from the Forest Acreage Tax, and with funds generated
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     from the sale of old equipment and lease of tower sites an amount
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     not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars ($750,000.00).
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     It is further the intention of the Legislature that the State
     Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate its budget in the
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     Subsidies, Loans and Grants major object of expenditure, with
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     funds generated from the Severance Tax to fund the Forest Resource
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     Development Program in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred
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     Thousand Dollars ($500,000.00).
                                      The receipt of these funds is
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hereby authorized and approved, provided such receipts and 194 195 expenditures are reported and otherwise accounted for in 196 accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq. and Section 27-104-1 et 197 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. 198 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 199 State Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate part-time 200 positions up to one hundred (100) and expend funds not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) from any source of 201 funds that become available to the commission. This escalation 202 203 shall be in accordance with rules and regulations of the 204 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. These positions may be used 205 206 to protect life and property during extended periods of extreme wildfire occurrences of a minimum of fifty (50) fires per day. 207 The escalation of positions and the expenditure of these funds 208 209 shall be at the discretion of the State Forester, with written 210 notification to the State Personnel Board and the State Fiscal 211 Officer. 212 SECTION 11. The Forestry Commission has the authority to 213 purchase from the "General Services Administration" Fire Fighter 214 Catalog and any other GSA Catalog as long as the cost of such 215 items are less than the quotes received. 216 SECTION 12. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a 217 fund designated as the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment 218 Conversion Revolving Fund to be used by the State Forestry Commission to assist in the conversion of vehicles acquired by the 219 220 State Forestry Commission through the Federal Excess Personal 221 Property Program or by Volunteer Fire Departments through other 222 means to adapt them for use in the suppression of wildland fires. 223 This assistance shall be in the form of fabrication of water tanks or other accessories necessary for the operation of fire 224 225 suppression units, installation of piping and valves, painting or 226 other similar or associated component work necessary to place fire

It is not for general vehicle 228 maintenance or repair. 229 The Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion Revolving 230 Fund shall be funded by monies received from charges for work and 231 services performed for Volunteer Fire Departments by the State 232 Forestry Commission. Monies collected from such charges shall be 233 deposited into the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion 234 Revolving Fund. The State Treasurer shall make disbursements 235 therefrom for payment of materials, supplies and labor upon 236 requisition of the Forestry Commission and upon the issuance of 237 warrants therefor by the Department of Finance and Administration. 238 The amount of monies deposited into the Volunteer Fire 239 Department Equipment Conversion Fund through this work shall not exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00). Funds in excess of 240 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be placed in the State 241 242 Forestry Commission's regular appropriated special funds. Monies 243 in this revolving fund are to be considered special funds and shall be carried forward from one fiscal year to the next. 244 245 SECTION 13. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund designated as the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund to be 246 247 used by the State Forestry Commission to direct forest management 248 activities on the Camden State Forest in Madison County, 249 Mississippi. The forest management activities will include, but 250 not be limited to, maintenance of property, timber sale activities 251 and regeneration work. 252 The Camden State Forest Revolving Fund shall be funded by 253 monies received from timber sales, leases, and any other source. 254 Monies collected from these income sources shall be deposited into 255 the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund. The State Treasurer shall 256 make disbursements therefrom for payments of materials, supplies and labor upon requisition of the State Forestry Commission and 257 258 upon the issuance of warrants therefor by the Department of 259 Finance and Administration.

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- It is the intention of the Legislature that any revolving 260 261 funds in excess of the budgeted amount needed for the necessary 262 operation and maintenance of all properties under the direct 263 supervision and management of the State Forestry Commission shall 264 remain in the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund for use in future 265 years. SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and 266 authorized for expenditure in Section 3, it is the intention of 267 the Legislature that Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) 268 269 shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce 270 for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal 271 Year 2007. 272 SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 273 Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed One Million Dollars 274 275 (\$1,000,000.00), from any source in accordance with rules and 276 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 277 278 SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that 279 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 280 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 281 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 282 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 283 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 284 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 285 made without competitive bids.
- 286 **SECTION 17.** Any person who was an employee of the Forestry
 287 Commission who was laid off during Fiscal Year 2006 shall be given
 288 first priority in any new employment by the commission.
- SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
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- 293 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 294 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 295 **SECTION 19.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 296 and after July 1, 2007.
