HOUSE BILL NO. 1699

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR FORESTERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2008.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 8 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters 9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning 10 11 July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... \$ 33,300.00. SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 12 13 State Board of Registration for Foresters shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 14 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 15 16 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 17 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 18 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 19

20 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 21 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

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28 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 29 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 30 31 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 32 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 33 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 34 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 35 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 37 and after July 1, 2007.
