HOUSE BILL NO. 1701

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY, FOR THE 3 FISCAL YEAR 2008; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 9 9,119,315.00. June 30, 2008..... \$ 10 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 12 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of 13 Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds 14 15 collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal 16 year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 17 18 \$ 3,403,944.00. SECTION 3. The State 75 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 76 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 77 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 78 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 79 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 80

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

85 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 86 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete 87 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 88 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 89 90 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 91 92 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

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95 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 96 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, 97 donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 98 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 99 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 100 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 101 102 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History.

110 **SECTION 7.** It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 111 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 112 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 113 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

114 SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums herein 115 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 116 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local 117 Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost 118 of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and 119 ending June 30, 2008.....\$ 75,052.00. 120 Of the funds appropriated in this section, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major 121

SECTION 9. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

187 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 188 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept, 189 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand 190 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to 191 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section

SECTION 11. Of the funds provided under the provisions of this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) is provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only President of the Confederate States of America.

SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 203 204 Executive Director of the Department of Archives and History may 205 authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 206 207 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 208 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be 209 210 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 211 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

212 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that 213 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 214 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 215 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 216 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 217 218 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 219 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Archives and History for the purpose of supporting the Statewide H. B. No. 1701 *HR05/A475* 07/HP05/A475

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Oral History Project for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007,
 and ending June 30, 2008...... \$ 150,000.00.

SECTION 15. Of the funds in Section 1, a sum not to exceed Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) is provided as matching funds for a Preserve America Grant to fund research and workshops on how to rebuild the Gulf Coast's Heritage Tourism Industry after Hurricane Katrina.

SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 232 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 233 234 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 235 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 236 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 237 SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from 238 and after July 1, 2007. 239
