1 2	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFR THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE FIRE ACADEMY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR				
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:				
4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State				
6	Treasury to the credit of the State Fire Academy Fund, for the				
7	purpose of defraying the expenses of the academy for the fiscal				
8	year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008				
9	\$ 6,480,777.00.				
10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
11	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be				
12	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of				
13	expenditure:

32	Funds are prov	ided herein to adjust the	Variable Compensation	
33	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase			
34	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation			
35	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever			
36	is greater.			
37	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of			
38	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to			
39	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal			
40	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008			
41	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions			
42	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the			
43	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the			
44	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall			
45	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all			
46	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this			
47	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure			
48	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual			
49	cost and/or the Fisc	cal Year 2008 appropriatio	on for "Personal	
50	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.			
51	If, at the time the	agency takes any action t	to change "Personal	
52	Services," the State	e Personnel Board determin	es that the agency	
53	has taken an action	which would cause the age	ency to exceed this

59	Any transfers	or escalations shall be ma	de in accordance with

- 62 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 63 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 64 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 65 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 66 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 67 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 69 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 70 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 71 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 72 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 73 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and
- 74 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 75 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 76 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 77 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 78 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
- 79 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 80 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 81 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
- 82 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 83 State Fire Academy shall have the authority to escalate and expend
- 84 funds, not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 85 (\$150,000.00), from any source that may become available to the
- 86 agency in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 87 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 88 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 89 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 90 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 91 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 92 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 93 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

- 94 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 95 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 96 made without competitive bids.
- 97 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 98 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 99 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 100 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 101 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 102 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 103 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 104 and after July 1, 2007.
