## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1734

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF NATCHEZ, MISSISSIPPI, AND OF THE NATCHEZ WATER WORKS IN ADAMS 2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO OPERATE ITS SEWER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM 3 4 WITHIN A CERTAIN DISTANCE OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY 5 OF NATCHEZ; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 8 21-27-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the governing authorities of the City of Natchez, Mississippi, and the Board of 9 Water Commissioners of the Natchez Water Works in Adams County, 10 Mississippi, in their discretion, may construct, expand, operate 11 12 and maintain that portion of the Water and Sewer Distribution System of the City of Natchez and of the Natchez Water Works that 13 14 pertains to providing sewer services only, for a distance not to exceed fifteen (15) miles from the corporate limits of the City of 15 Natchez within any area not otherwise certificated to another 16 water or sewer utility system for such service, upon obtaining a 17 18 certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Mississippi Public Service Commission. Whenever such utility 19 service is furnished to any customer outside the corporate limits 20 21 of the City of Natchez, the consumer may not be charged at a rate 2.2 greater than twice the rate charged for the same service within the corporate limits of the City of Natchez. 23

(2) The authority conferred by this act shall not be

construed as an exemption from the provisions of Section 77-3-1 et

seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, as to the requirements

for obtaining a certificate of public convenience and necessity,
