HOUSE BILL NO. 1749

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO EDWARD CARTER,
2 SR., OF CLAIBORNE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Edward Carter, Sr., of Claiborne County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction of the crime of embezzlement in 1998 in Claiborne
8 County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve one (1) year
9 in the custody of the Department of Corrections. He was released
10 on April 9, 1999, on expiration of sentence and placed on
11 probation with a projected discharge date of April 9, 2003, and
12 completed his probation on April 11, 2003. He has since conducted
13 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
14 lawful manner.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
16 and after its passage.
