HOUSE BILL NO. 1808

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 823, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1988, 1 TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE HARRISON COUNTY BEAUTIFICATION 2 3 COMMITTEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 823, Local and Private Laws of 1988, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 Section 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Harrison County, Mississippi, is hereby authorized and empowered, in its 8 discretion, to establish a county beautification commission. 9 (2) Until the effective date of House Bill No. 1808, 2007 10 11 Regular Session, the county beautification commission shall be composed of fifteen (15) members who shall be appointed in the 12 13 following manner: five (5) members shall be appointed by a majority vote of the board of supervisors, with one (1) member 14 15 being appointed from each supervisors district in the county; six (6) members to be appointed by the six (6) chambers of commerce in 16 the county, with one (1) of such members being appointed by each 17 18 of such chambers of commerce; and four (4) members to be appointed by the mayors of the four (4) municipalities in the county, with 19 one (1) of such members being appointed by each of such mayors. 20 Each commissioner so appointed shall serve for a term to run 21 concurrently with the term of a member of the board of 22 supervisors; however, the term of the members serving on the 23 effective date of House Bill No. 1808, 2007 Regular Session, shall 24 be terminated upon the effective date of such act. Any vacancy in 25 the office of a commissioner shall be filled by the board of 26 27 supervisors, the chamber of commerce in such county, or mayor of

(3) From and after the effective date of House Bill No. 31 32 1808, 2007 Regular Session, the county beautification commission shall be composed of seven (7) members who shall be appointed in 33 the following manner: one (1) member shall be appointed by each 34 member of the board of supervisors from the appointing supervisors 35 36 district, and two (2) members shall be appointed from the county 37 at large by a majority vote of the board of supervisors. Each 38 commissioner so appointed shall serve for a term to run concurrently with the term of the appointing member of the board 39 of supervisors. Any vacancy in the office of a commissioner shall 40 41 be filled in the same manner as the original appointment, and the appointee shall serve only until the expiration of the term of his 42 43 immediate predecessor.

44 Section 2. (1) If the Board of Supervisors of Harrison 45 County, Mississippi, establishes a county beautification 46 commission as authorized under Section 1 of this act, then the 47 board of supervisors shall be:

48 Authorized to expend monies not to exceed Fifty (a) 49 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) annually, out of any available funds 50 of the county for the operation of the beautification commission, including the hiring of necessary personnel, and such expenses 51 52 related to education, advertising and any other expenses incidental to the purposes and intent of the commission. 53 However, 54 employees of the commission shall be under the direct control and supervision of the county beautification commission. 55 No expenditures shall be made by the commission except in accordance 56 57 with a budget approved by the board of supervisors.

58 (b) Authorized, notwithstanding the provisions of any 59 other law to the contrary, to appropriate funds not to exceed the 60 amount authorized in this section, to the county beautification

64 (c) Authorized to accept grants, gifts and donations
65 not to exceed the amount authorized in this section, from public
66 and private sources for the use of the county beautification
67 commission, upon appropriation by the board, in its purposes as
68 set forth in this act.

69 (2) If the Board of Supervisors of Harrison County 70 establishes a county beautification commission as authorized under 71 Section 1 of this act, then the board of supervisors may adopt 72 such rules, regulations and ordinances as, in its discretion, it 73 deems necessary to the effective and efficient operation of the 74 county beautification commission.

75 Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 76 and after its passage.

77 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from78 and after its passage.
