HOUSE BILL NO. 1814

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WARREN  
2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO RECEIVE CERTAIN FUNDS FROM AN INCREASE IN  
3 THE RATE OF COMMERCIAL MOBILE RADIO SERVICE EMERGENCY TELEPHONE  
4 SERVICE (CMRS) CHARGE WITHIN THE EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE  
5 (E-911) DISTRICT ENCOMPASSING WARREN COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED  
6 PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** (1) Notwithstanding Section 19-5-333(2),  
9 Mississippi Code of 1972, to the contrary, the Commercial Mobile  
10 Radio Service (CMRS) Board is authorized to collect and distribute  
11 a CMRS emergency telephone service charge for Warren County on  
12 each CMRS customer whose place of primary use is within Warren  
13 County at a rate of up to Three Dollars (\$3.00) per month per CMRS  
14 connection within the Emergency Telephone Service (E-911) District  
15 encompassing the whole Warren County.

16 (2) The Emergency Telephone Service (E-911) District  
17 encompassing the whole Warren County, shall receive funds that  
18 shall not be less than seventy percent (70%) of the total funds  
19 collected by the CMRS Board based on the rate of up to Three  
20 Dollars (\$3.00) per month per CMRS connection within such  
21 district, and such funds shall be used to provide E-911 service,  
22 including capital improvements and for the district's normal  
23 operations in providing wireless E-911 service.

24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
25 and after its passage.
