HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 35

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CAREER AND DEDICATED
2 SERVICE OF TRUETT ROBERTSON, AND CONGRATULATING HIM UPON THE
3 OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF
4 WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS.

5 WHEREAS, since March 10, 1978, Truett Robertson has
6 diligently served the citizens of Mississippi and Neshoba County
7 as he carried out his duties as a conservation officer and
8 conservation officer supervisor with the Mississippi Department of
9 Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks until his retirement on June 30,
10 2006, ending 28 years of exemplary service; and

11 WHEREAS, rising through the ranks, Mr. Robertson obtained the
12 rank of lieutenant, which resulted in a promotion to District 4
13 Conservation Officer Supervisor, overseeing officers from Scott,
14 Lauderdale, Kemper, Newton and Neshoba Counties; and

15 WHEREAS, throughout his career he supervised personnel from
16 the Fisheries, Wildlife and Law Enforcement Bureaus and garnered
17 the respect of his colleagues, who held him in high esteem for his
18 open mind and fair administration of policies of the agency; and

19 WHEREAS, for the 28 plus years of service and dedication Mr.
20 Robertson has rendered to the people and sportsmen of East Central
21 Mississippi, he has set the standard by which any who follow will
22 be challenged; and

23 WHEREAS, supervising ten law enforcement personnel at the
24 time of his retirement in June, Mr. Robertson's abilities to
25 bridge the gaps and personalities of the people he served will
26 long be remembered in District 4; and

27 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to commend the
28 remarkable service and extreme dedication of state employees of

29 Mr. Robertson's caliber, whose zealous commitment to his fellowman
30 has gained him great respect and distinction:

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
32 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
33 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Truett
34 Robertson on the occasion of his retirement from the Mississippi
35 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks after more than 28
36 years of service and express warmest wishes for continued success
37 in all his future endeavors.
