5	WHEREAS, the health of our children is of paramount
6	importance to families in the State of Mississippi; and
7	WHEREAS, poor child health is a threat to the educational
8	achievement, social and psychological well-being of the children
9	of our state; and
10	WHEREAS, protecting the health of our children is essential
11	to the well-being of our youngest citizens and the quality of life
12	in Mississippi; and
13	WHEREAS, the State Children's Health Insurance Program
14	(SCHIP), which has enrolled thousands of uninsured children in
15	Mississippi since its inception in 1998, is an integral part of
16	the arrangements for health benefits for the children of this
17	state; and
18	WHEREAS, SCHIP is a valuable program in preserving child
19	wellness, preventing and treating childhood disease, improving
20	health outcomes, and reducing overall health costs; and
21	WHEREAS, the Legislature considers that federal funding for
22	SCHIP is indispensable to providing health benefits for children
23	of modest means in Mississippi:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF

THEREIN, That the Legislature urges the members of the Mississippi

delegation to the United States Congress to do all within their

power to ensure that Congress timely reauthorizes the State

- 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature urges the
- 32 Governor to use his best efforts to work with the Mississippi
- 33 congressional delegation to ensure that SCHIP is reauthorized in a
- 34 timely manner.
- 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature declares that
- 36 all components of state government should work together with
- 37 educators, health care providers, social workers, and parents
- 38 to ensure that all available public and private assistance for
- 39 providing health benefits to uninsured children in this state is
- 40 used to the maximum extent possible.
- 41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature urges the
- 42 Governor to use his best efforts to provide meaningful assistance
- 43 to help identify and enroll children who qualify for Medicaid or
- 44 SCHIP.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
- 46 furnished to the members of the Mississippi congressional
- 47 delegation, the Governor and to the members of the Capitol Press
- 48 Corps.

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
