## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 73

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING MS.

29 endeavors by her son, William, and daughters, Debbie and Donna,  
30 along with their spouses, and her six adorable grandchildren; and
