HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 98

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE UNITED STATES PRESIDENT 2 AND CONGRESS TO SUPPORT THE "25 BY 25" INITIATIVE PROMOTING 3 AGRICULTURAL-BASED RENEWABLE ENERGY.

WHEREAS, having an affordable, reliable, and plentiful energy supply is crucial to our economy, as well as to our national and international food supply; and

7 WHEREAS, current and future risks to United States energy 8 security are mounting, while domestic and global energy demands 9 are escalating; and

10 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi has tremendous renewable 11 energy resources and affordable electric rates; and

WHEREAS, the development of renewable energy sources, including wind power, biodiesel, biomass, methane digesters, ethanol and solar, benefits the environment and will have a direct economic benefit to agricultural landowners and rural communities only if electric rates do not increase; and

WHEREAS, agricultural communities and their partners will experience multiple benefits, including establishing additional markets for agricultural commodities; increasing farm income; creating added-value uses for crops, livestock, and their byproducts; and creating new job opportunities; and

25 WHEREAS, America's farms and ranches can become the factories 26 that produce a new generation of fuels to help meet the nation's 27 energy needs; and

32 WHEREAS, agriculture's role as an energy producer will have a 33 positive effect on national security and trade imbalances and will 34 serve as a catalyst for rural development in the State of 35 Mississippi only if electric rates do not increase due to mandated 36 renewables:

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING 38 THEREIN, That we, the members of the Mississippi Legislature, 39 support and endorse the vision of "25 by 25," under which 40 agriculture will provide 25% of the total energy consumed in the 41 United States by the year 2025, while continuing to produce 42 43 abundant, safe and affordable food and fiber and enjoying 44 affordable electric rates .

45 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature urges the 46 President and Congress of the United States to support the "25 by 47 25" initiative promoting the use of agricultural-based renewable 48 energy as a goal, not as a mandate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be furnished to the President of the United States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the members of the Mississippi Congressional Delegation, the Secretary of the United States Department of Energy, the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture, and the members of the Capitol Press Corps.
