DAVID ABNEY ON 1 2 BEING NAMED CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER OF THE UNITED PARCEL SERVICE, 3 INC., AND COMMENDING HIM FOR HIS INTEREST IN THE FUTURE OF YOUNG 4 MISSISSIPPIANS AND FOR HIS CONTINUED SUPPORT OF DELTA STATE 5 UNIVERSITY. 6 WHEREAS, in January 2007, a great honor was bestowed upon Mr. David Abney when a global icon, the United Parcel Service, Inc. 7 (UPS), an international package delivery company, promoted him as 8 9 the company's chief operating officer; and 10 WHEREAS, as chief operating officer of this international company, he also assumes the role of President of UPS Airlines; 11 12 and WHEREAS, 51-year-old Mr. Abney will be responsible for 13 14 international operations, United States package operations, global transportation, labor and all freight activities; and 15 WHEREAS, Mr. Abney is a homegrown Mississippian who was born 16 in Cleveland, Mississippi, reared in Greenwood, Mississippi, and 17 graduated from Delta State University in 1976 with a bachelor of 18 19 business administration degree; and WHEREAS, Mr. Abney began his career with UPS as a part-time 20 21 employee on its loading dock while he was a student at Delta State 2.2 University, and upon graduation, he accepted a job at UPS to drive one of its delivery vehicles within Mississippi; and 23 WHEREAS, by the mid-1980s, he served as a manager of UPS's 24 busy hub, feeder and air division office in Jackson, Mississippi, 25 and went on to serve in various capacities in the company, 26 including the role of Utah district manager, as well as directing 27 28 various freight and logistics operations in the United States,

29 Canada and Latin America, until 2002, when he went on to serve as 30 the President of UPS International; and

31 WHEREAS, he believes that his values of a tenacious 32 commitment to hard work, to the community, and to integrity were 33 learned while he was a student at Delta State University and are 34 the same values shared by his 32-year employer, which in his 35 opinion are fundamental to each organization's longevity; and

36 WHEREAS, although Mr. Abney's worldwide responsibilities 37 require him to travel the globe, he carves out time to go back 38 home and share insight with young Mississippians at his alma 39 mater, Delta State University; and

WHEREAS, because of Mr. Abney's appreciation for the values he learned as a college student, he has a love of Delta State University that has motivated him to become a member of the Delta State University Foundation Board of Directors and the founder and donor of the David Abney International Business Symposium held annually at the university as a way to educate and expose students to international issues; and

WHEREAS, over the past few years, Mr. Abney has been a featured speaker on global trade at leading forums including: the World Economic Forum in Davos, the Executives Club of Chicago and Fudan University in Shanghai; and
