3 HEAD COACH DARRIN GRAY FOR MAKING HISTORY BY BEING THE FIRST TEAM
4 IN THE SCHOOL'S HISTORY TO MAKE IT TO THE STATE TOURNAMENT AND
5 WINNING THE CLASS 2A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

7 Basketball Team made history this year by being the first boys
8 basketball team in the school's history to advance to the state
9 tournament; and

14 lost 11 games; and

16 Darrin Gray, and Assistant Coach Timothy White; and

17 WHEREAS, not only has the team gained recognition for its
18 athletic prowess, honors have been bestowed upon individual team
19 members; and

20 WHEREAS, Kenneth Barlow was awarded as Most Valuable Player
21 in Division VI Basketball, Kenneth Barlow, Kendrick McKee and
22 Michael Wells were honored as All-Division Players, Kendrick McKee
23 was awarded Most Valuable Player for the State Championship Game,
24 and Kenneth Barlow, Kendrick McKee and Michael Wells were named
25 All-State Players; and

26 WHEREAS, Kenneth Barlow will bring more notoriety to the
27 school this summer by playing in the Mississippi All-Star Game for
28 the South Squad; and

29 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
30 and commend the special accomplishments of student athletes who
31 not only bring honor to their schools but to their state:
