HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 10

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND HOUSE RULE 95 OF THE HOUSE RULES TO 1 DECREASE FROM TWO-THIRDS TO MAJORITY THE VOTE REQUIRED TO WITHDRAW 2 3 A BILL FROM COMMITTEE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE 4 5 OF MISSISSIPPI, That Rule 95 of the 2004-2008 Rules of the House of Representatives is amended as follows: 6 7 "95. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (2), 8 (3) and (4) of this rule, every House bill, resolution or measure 9 referred to any committee, and not reported therefrom with a recommendation by the twenty-seventh day of a ninety-day session 10 11 and by the sixty-second day of a one-hundred-twenty-five-day session, and every Senate bill, resolution or measure referred to 12 any committee, and not reported therefrom by the fifty-fifth day 13 of a ninety-day session and by the ninetieth day of a 14 15 one-hundred-twenty-five-day session, may be withdrawn from the committee on a motion made in writing, which motion must be read 16 by the clerk immediately upon its introduction, setting forth the 17 reasons why the bill should be withdrawn from the committee, by a 18 vote of a majority of the members elected to the House. It may 19 then be taken up and considered by the Committee of the Whole 20 House in accordance with the procedure set forth in House Rule 56, 2.1 or, by a majority vote of those present and voting it may be 22 recommitted to a standing committee. During extraordinary or 23 special sessions of the Legislature, any bill, including an 24 appropriation or revenue bill, may be withdrawn from committee 25 after three (3) days from the date of reference. A motion to 26

withdraw a bill from a committee shall not be voted upon by the

- 28 House on the day which the motion is made, except upon suspension
- 29 of the rules by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present and
- 30 voting.
- 31 (2) Any House appropriation bill or revenue bill referred to
- 32 the House Appropriations Committee or the House Ways and Means
- 33 Committee and not reported therefrom with a recommendation within
- 34 ten (10) legislative days after referral may be withdrawn from the
- 35 committee in accordance with the procedure set forth in subsection
- 36 (1) of this rule if the motion for withdrawal is made by the
- 37 fiftieth day of a ninety-day session and by the eighty-fifth day
- 38 of a one-hundred-twenty-five-day session.
- 39 (3) Any Senate appropriation bill or revenue bill referred
- 40 to the House Appropriations Committee or the House Ways and Means
- 41 Committee and not reported therefrom with a recommendation within
- 42 ten (10) legislative days after referral may be withdrawn from the
- 43 committee in accordance with the procedure set forth in subsection
- 44 (1) of this rule if the motion for withdrawal is made by the
- 45 seventieth day of a ninety-day session and by the
- 46 one-hundred-fifth day of a one-hundred-twenty-five-day session.
- 47 (4) For the purposes of this rule, the term 'revenue bill'
- 48 shall include only those bills whose primary purpose is to
- 49 increase or decrease taxes or to authorize the issuance of bonds
- 50 or the borrowing of money. Bills which are primarily for
- 51 regulatory purposes which have revenue provisions included shall
- 52 not be considered as revenue bills for the purposes of this rule."
