1 2 3	A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE ATHLETIC SUCCESS OF BRADFORD BLACKMON AND CONGRATULATING HIM UPON BEING NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR ON $THE\ CLARION-LEDGER\ ALL-METRO\ FOOTBALL\ TEAM.$
4	WHEREAS, St. Andrew's senior Bradford Blackmon, has stamped
5	his name in the school's record book and in the hearts of the
6	Saints' faithful supporters throughout a year of most spectacular
7	and eye-catching play, catapulting him to the top position of
8	being named Player of the Year on The Clarion-Ledger All-Metro
9	Football Team; and
10	WHEREAS, the legacy and mind-boggling numbers left behind by
11	this do-everything star is one that falls nothing short of simply
12	astonishing, as Bradford has amassed an eye-popping 9,364
13	all-purpose yards in his career, by completing 716 rushes for
14	5,553 rushing yards, catching 98 passes for 1,986 receiving yards
15	and 106 touchdowns, including 30 this season when he led the
16	Saints to the Class 2A semifinalsthe deepest playoff run in
17	school history; and
18	WHEREAS, Bradford has been described by his coach, David
19	Bradberry, as being the singular player of any program he has ever
20	coached, to have such an impact on winning, evidenced by his 106
21	career touchdowns, ranking him third on the state's all-time list
22	and trailer of such notables as former Weir star, Dicenzo Miller,
23	with 118 and ex-Lumberton back, Terry Grant with 115; and
24	WHEREAS, undisputedly a very gifted and talented athlete,
25	Bradford's honors and awards have served notice to the state and

regional high schools and collegiate scouts that he is a force to

be reckoned with, including: having been named as team most

- 37 Valuable Offensive Player State 2A, BankPlus Blitz 16 All-Metro
- 38 Player of the Year, nominated for the Wendy's High School Heisman
- 39 Award and named to The Orlando Florida Sentinel Newspaper
- 40 All-Southern Football Team; and
- WHEREAS, standing 5 feet 9 inches and weighing in at 170
- 42 lbs., Bradford, who is a hero among heroes in the eyes of the
- 43 throng of elementary students who mob him after each game, is
- 44 destined to be remembered for his exploits on the field, but the
- 45 demeanor exhibited off the field, is what will be remembered most
- 46 by those who look up to him as a role model and a teammate; and
- WHEREAS, humble in his decorum in the face of athletic
- 48 stardom, Bradford who has been sought after by Jackson State
- 49 University, and Ivy League members, Columbia and Pennsylvania,
- 50 credits his fellow teammates and the team effort for making it all
- 51 possible, which speaks volumes of his athletic tenacity, skill and
- 52 versatility as well as his academic success as an honor student
- 53 from Grades K-12; and
- WHEREAS, during Bradford's tenure as a member of the St.
- 55 Andrew's Episcopal Football Team from 2003-2006, the Saints
- 56 compiled a record of 35-13, going undefeated with a 10-0 record in
- 57 2004 and a record of 9-1 for the 2006 season; and
- WHEREAS, as Bradford has garnered a myriad of supporters and
- 59 well-wishers on the state and regional level, he promises to catch

60	the eye of millions nationwide as a new Quaker upon having
61	committed to the University of Pennsylvania in the Ivy League; and
62	WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
63	recognize and commend excellence as exhibited by scholar-athletes
64	such as Bradford Blackmon, whose dynamic and unrivaled athleticism
65	coupled with his gentle nature and academic achievement
