1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE ATHLETIC SUCCESS OF BRADFORD 2 BLACKMON AND CONGRATULATING HIM UPON BEING NAMED PLAYER OF THE 3 YEAR ON *THE CLARION-LEDGER* ALL-METRO FOOTBALL TEAM.

WHEREAS, St. Andrew's senior Bradford Blackmon, has stamped his name in the school's record book and in the hearts of the Saints' faithful supporters throughout a year of most spectacular and eye-catching play, catapulting him to the top position of being named Player of the Year on *The Clarion-Ledger* All-Metro Football Team; and

WHEREAS, the legacy and mind-boggling numbers left behind by 10 11 this do-everything star is one that falls nothing short of simply astonishing, as Bradford has amassed an eye-popping 9,364 12 13 all-purpose yards in his career, by completing 716 rushes for 5,553 rushing yards, catching 98 passes for 1,986 receiving yards 14 15 and 106 touchdowns, including 30 this season when he led the Saints to the Class 2A semifinals--the deepest playoff run in 16 17 school history; and

WHEREAS, Bradford has been described by his coach, David Bradberry, as being the singular player of any program he has ever coached, to have such an impact on winning, evidenced by his 106 career touchdowns, ranking him third on the state's all-time list and trailer of such notables as former Weir star, Dicenzo Miller, with 118 and ex-Lumberton back, Terry Grant with 115; and

valuable player for each year beginning 2003 through 2006; named 28 29 to the Madison County Herald All-County Team for each year 30 beginning 2003 through 2006; named to the First Team All-District 6-2A in 2003; named to Second Team All-State 2A and most valuable 31 32 offensive player for District 6-2A in 2004; named to the 33 All-District Boys' Basketball Team District 6-2A, First Team 34 All-Metro, First Team All-State 2A, Most Valuable Player for District 6-2A and BankPlus Blitz 16 Player of the Week in 2005; 35 and First Team All-State 2A, First Team All-State Overall, Most 36 37 Valuable Offensive Player State 2A, BankPlus Blitz 16 All-Metro Player of the Year, nominated for the Wendy's High School Heisman 38 39 Award and named to The Orlando Florida Sentinel Newspaper All-Southern Football Team; and 40

WHEREAS, humble in his decorum in the face of athletic
stardom, Bradford who has been sought after by Jackson State
University, and Ivy League members, Columbia and Pennsylvania,
credits his fellow teammates and the team effort for making it all
possible, which speaks volumes of his athletic tenacity, skill and
versatility as well as his academic success as an honor student
from Grades K-12; and
