- 17 three-yard touchdown four plays into the second half for a 35-28
- 18 Mudcats lead; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the Mudcats' victory is credited to the team's
- 20 tenacious sportsmanship that "wore out" the offensive line of the
- 21 Pittsburgh RiverRats; and
- 22 WHEREAS, the Mudcats were coached to victory by Head Coach
- 23 Brian Brents; and
