13 their first track 5A State Championship; and

14 WHEREAS, in addition to her superb performance on the track
15 field, Ms. Eads also excels in her academics at Brandon High
16 School; and

17 WHEREAS, Ms. Eads is a member of the prestigious National
18 Honor Society where she exudes the principles of the honor society
19 which are scholarship, service, leadership, character and
20 citizenship; and

21 WHEREAS, in addition to being a member of the National Honor
22 Society, Ms. Eads is also a member of the Beta Club which speaks
23 volumes of her academic achievements; and

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Eads also had the notable accomplishment of
25 representing Brandon High School in the Hugh O'Brien Youth
26 Leadership Conference at Millsaps College where her leadership

27 skills were honed and have been an asset for Ms. Eads as she
