## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 48

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF MRS. NAREATHA  
2 WOULLARD NAYLOR AND EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HER FAMILY AND

5 late Reverend and Mrs. Ralph W. Woullard, Sr., in Hattiesburg,  
6 Mississippi, departed this earthly life on Sunday, February 18,  
7 2007, causing great sorrow and loss to her family and friends; and

9 graduated from Lincoln University in Jefferson City, Missouri,

22 loved her best, her survivors: daughter, Frances Naylor Johnson;
